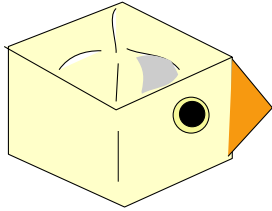


Fold and unfold diagonal creases on the front flap. Then fold up the front flap as far as it will go. Tuck 'A' under 'B' and 'C' under 'D'.

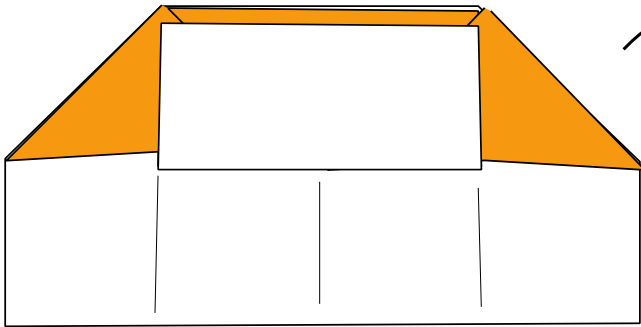
