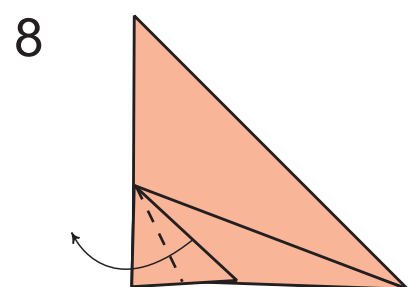
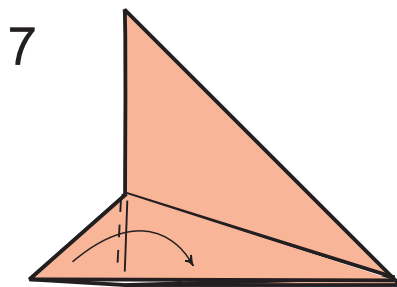
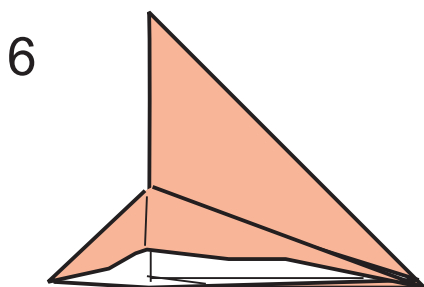
You need one quarter of a sheet of origami paper. A 7.5 cm. square will work well.



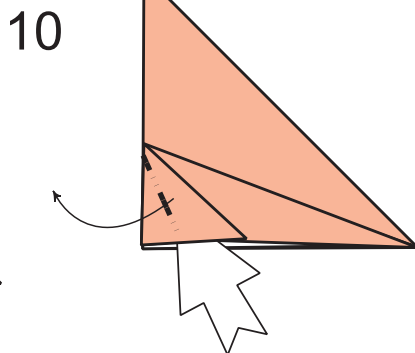
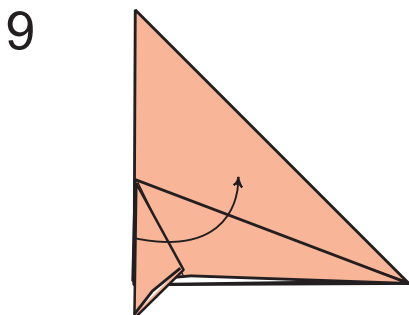
Fold behind.



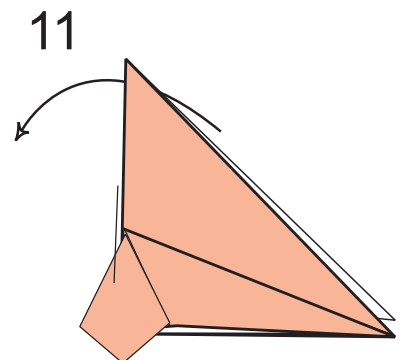
Place your finger inside the pocket to open.



Press flat.

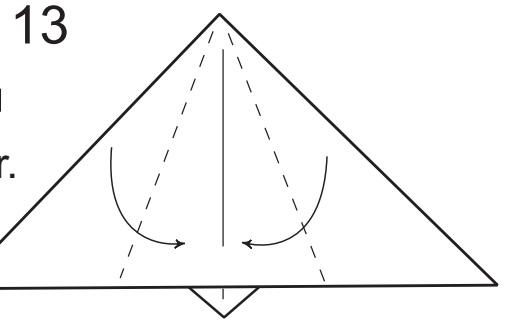
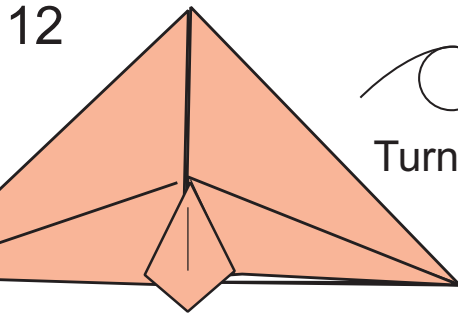
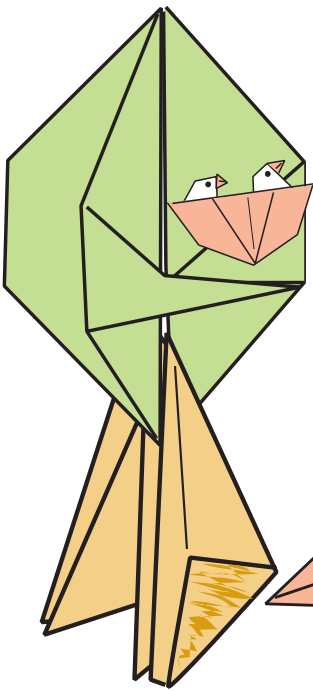


Open the small triangular flap and flatten.



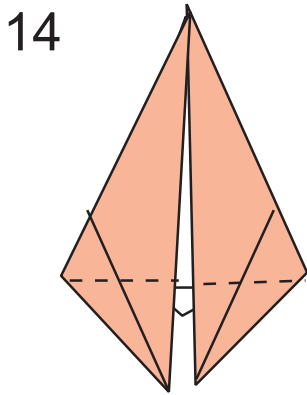

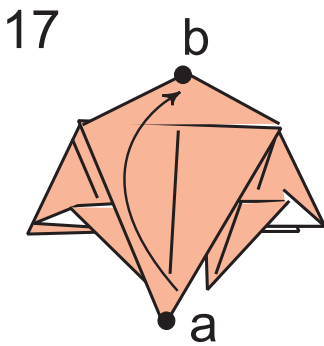
Fold the slanted sides to the center leaving a small space.



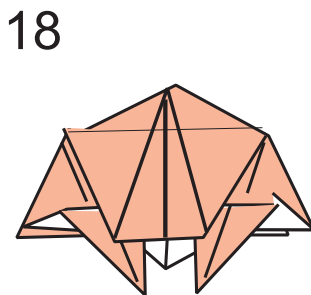
Fold up both flaps.



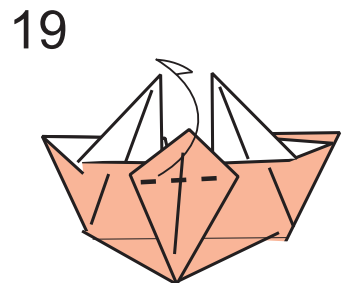
Fold down point 'a' as far as the flap will go.



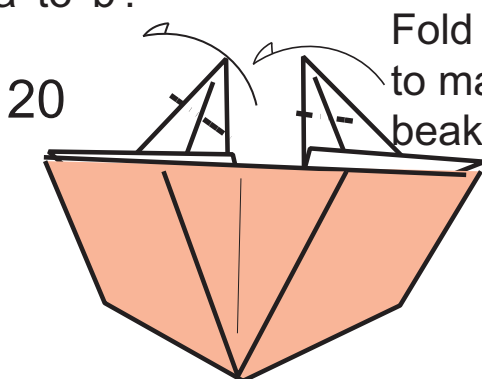
Fold 'a' to 'b'.



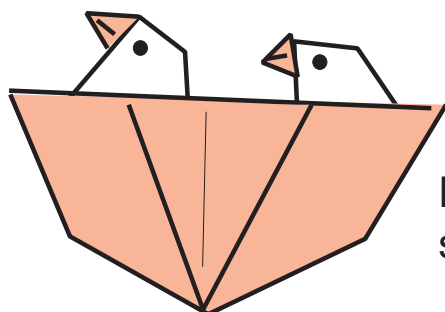
Turn over.



Fold the top of the diamond inside the pocket.



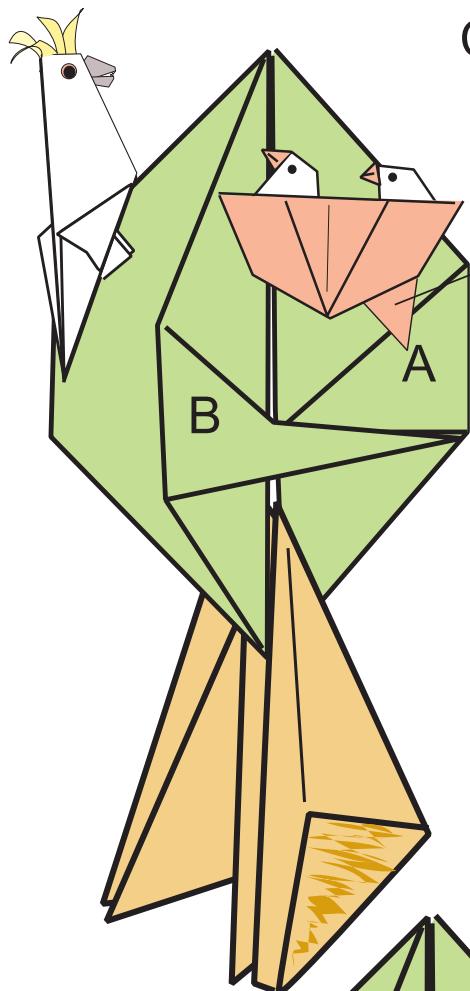
Fold behind to make the beaks.



Draw some eyes.

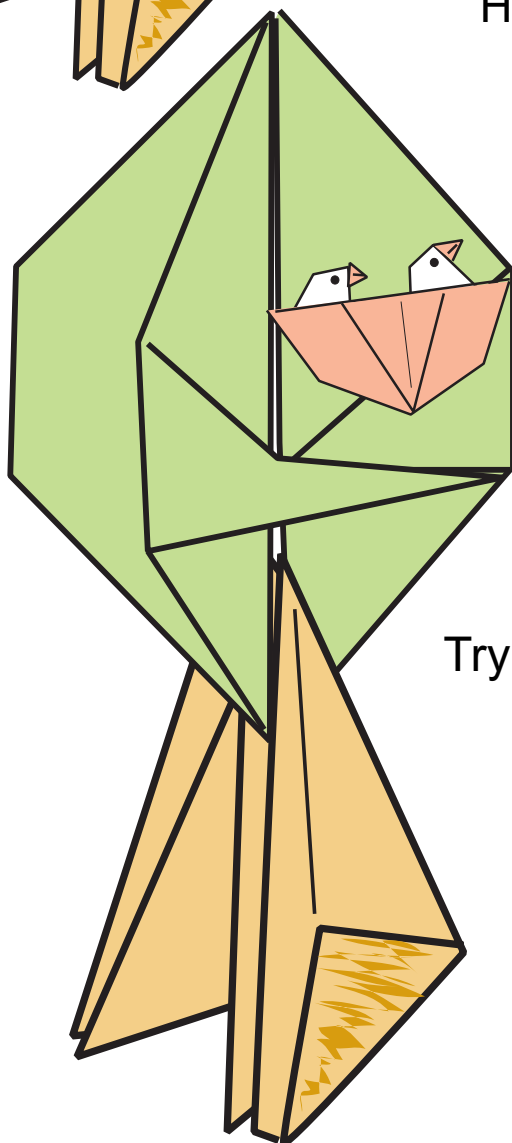
