

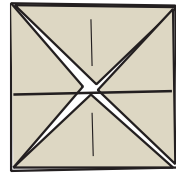

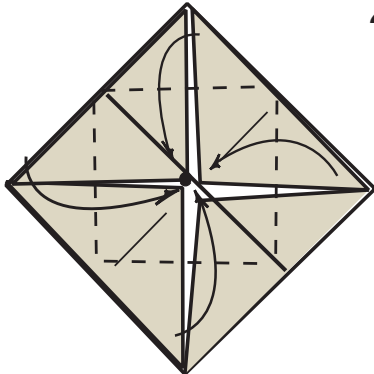
You need 2 sheets of origami paper the same size.

(Head of the cat)

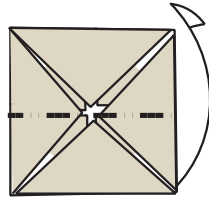


Start with a blintz base.

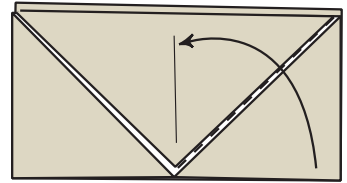

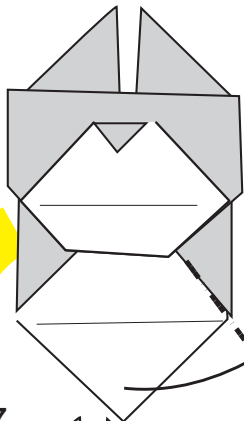
Carefully pull out the loose flap 'a' so that points 'b' and 'c' don't tear.

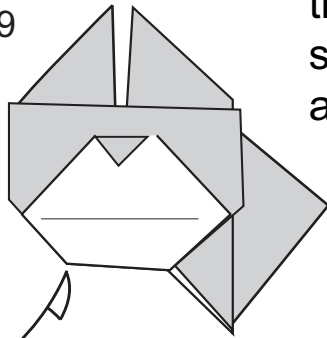


Repeat on the other side.

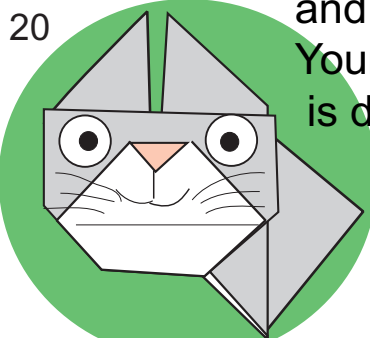

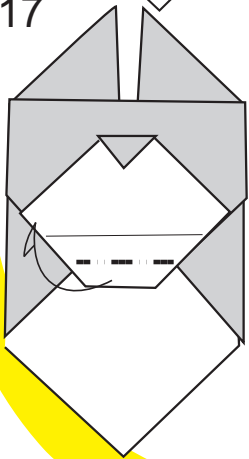
Attach round stickers for eyes and draw eyeballs. Your cat's cute face is done.



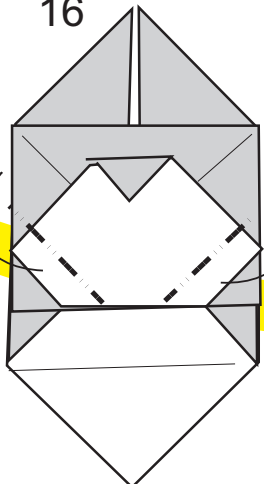
