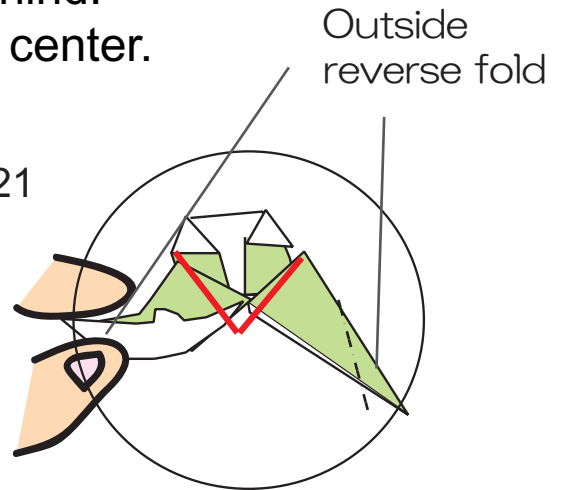


Lift up the flap. Fold the top point behind.

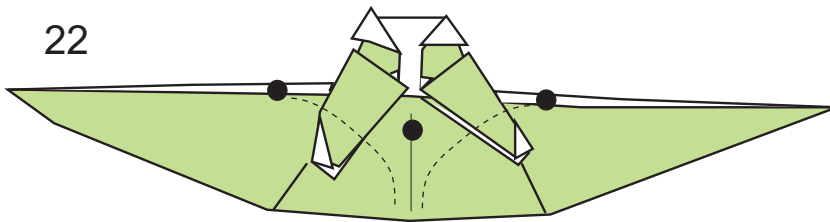

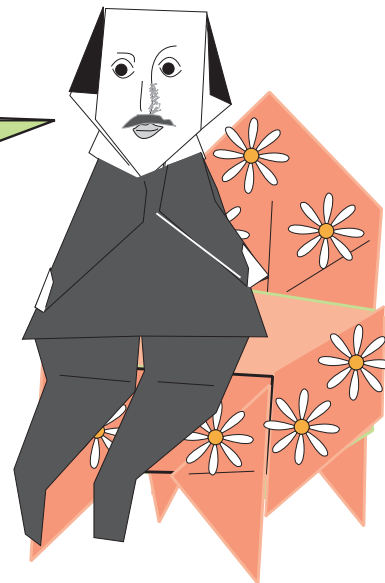
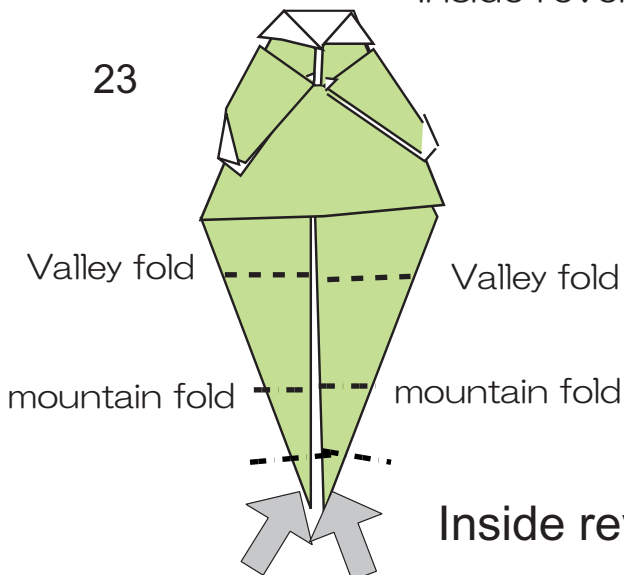
Cut on the center line of the triangular flap to form the arms.
